

ACEN EQUITY SCHOLARSHIP - RECORDED VIDEO APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Why do you need to submit a video?

As an applicant for the ACEN Equity Scholarship, we require a pre-recorded video interview so we can learn more about you, assess your suitability for receiving the scholarship and completing a Global Online Internship.

Unlike a live phone or video interview, a pre-recorded video submission allows you to express yourself in a comfortable environment and summarise in your own words who you are and your motivations for applying. Not only will you be able to cover all your strengths into just one video, but you'll benefit from self-reflecting on your current goals and experience, as well as gaining some practice communicating these concisely!

How will your video submission be used?

We will use your video to assess your application, learn about you and understand your expectations. Your video will be watched by the Pagoda placements team who will provide recommendations to ACEN, who own the scholarship, for final decisions. Pagoda's host companies may also watch your video to assess your application for an internship with them should your application be successful.

Video guidelines

When recording your video, please follow the recommendations below:

- Your video should be no longer than 3-5 minutes
- Record in landscape orientation
- Choose a place to record with a plain/neutral background
- Record in a quiet place with little to no background noise

No editing is needed in your video whatsoever. You won't be judged on your video quality at all however we always appreciate clear audio and images therefore please do follow the guidelines above.

During your 3-5-minute video, please answer the following questions:

- Tell us about any previous work experience you have and the skills you have that make you a good candidate for this programme.
- How do you think this experience will benefit your future career?
- What type of internship role are you looking for, what responsibilities are you expecting to have on place and what skills are you looking to practice during the remote internship?
- If successful, what potential challenges do you think you could face during your remote internship?
- Why do you think you should be awarded the scholarship?

How do you submit your video?

You have two options to submit your video; please see below:

- Send your video submission to interviews@pagodaprojects.com with the file name '(Full Name) (Your University) Video Interview'. To send large files, please use https://wetransfer.com/.
- Create a YouTube account, upload your video as 'private' and send the video link via email.

Although a pre-recorded interview is preferred, if you are uncomfortable with this method then please let us know so that we can arrange an alternative option for you.
